Each morning shooting will commence at 09.00, except Saturday which will commence at 10.00, and finish at 13.00. Each afternoon, EXCEPT THE LAST DAY, shooting will commence at 14.00 and finish at 18.00.

During the week firing points will be available for practice and unsquadded competition shooting.

In all squadded competitions every effort will be made to squad all competitors in any one class together. This may not be possible if entries exceed range capacity.
