Cancellations

- (a) The mooted Easter match in Jersey has fallen through.
- (b) The Air Weapons match in Cardiff in April has been cancelled as it clashes with a major event in Europe.
- (c) With profound regret Eley have advised that they are unable to continue providing the Silver Salvors for the big Winter Competition. We have thanked them for the excellent support they have given us over the years. The firm of Tasco is donating four of their 29T 22 x 60 mm. Spotting Scopes for the four class winners in next year's Medal competition.

Freuchie 1981

Tasco is donating a further four scopes for the 1981 Freuchie competition at Stirling. The three finalists will receive one each and one will go to the best C and D class performance (see below). You are reminded that the entry is limited to 81 and the competition runs during the lunch break on the Monday, Tuesday and Thursday of the Scottish meeting. It is knock-out in form and each round is against the two other competitors in the same shooting frame. The finals are on the Thursday at 5.30 p.m. for the Wilkinson Sword and Tasco scopes.

An amendment is being made to the C and D prize to ensure a final of three shooters. The three who will contest this Final will be those who progress furthest or have the best gun scores in the round where the last of the class are eliminated but will exclude any who reach the main Final, e.g. if two reach the semi-final and are then eliminated, they plus the highest scoring C or D class non-qualifier from the second round will shoot it out for the spotting scope.

Team Trials 1981

Entries are open up to 5th May for the Postal Stage (60 pence to Individual Members, 80 pence to Club Members), the best 15 in which will qualify for the Final trial at Denwood on 17th May. As last year there is a separate section for Ladies & Juniors in the Final Trial.

Summer Air Rifle & Pistol Leagues
