Procedures: Shooters are hereby reminded:-

- (a) we still operate the system of allowing an additional shot in the event of a clean non-scoring shot, on penalty of two points,
- (b) care should be exercised in this regard in the 6 yard recoiling leagues (Divisions X1 & X2) on which the shots are scored with the larger (more generous) gauge to accommodate .22 rifles,
- (c) all cards must be signed by the shooter and by a competent witness.
