Meetings

(a) Air Weapons. The Association's annual Open Meeting and Scottish Championship are being hosted this year by the Glenrothes Club on 3rd/4th April. The rifle programme includes both 10 metres and 6 yards, with separate events for ordinary recoiling air rifles (.177 or .22), and pistol is at 10 metres. Weapons will be available for the casual interested shooter to try his/her skill and the club is running a Stiga moving target range for your fun/their funds. Entry forms from R. Normand.
