1983 Postal Match: Scotland v New Zealand. Scotland won 5920-5913 to take lead 6-4 in the annual series. In their 1984 match shot on 25th March Scotland slipped below the high standard of the past 4 years - estimate 5893.

Air Weapons. The 1984 Championship Meeting will be held jointly with the S.P.A. at the Inverclyde National Sports Training Centre, Largs, on 14th/15th April. There is a full programme of rifle and pistol, 10 metres and 6 yards, recoilless & recoiling. Field target shooting will be introduced and offers the use of equipment to come-and-try. Junior Match. The Junior (under 21, 30th June, 1984) match with Lancashire will take place in Lancashire in July. The team of 8 will be selected after the Trials (enter via Team Trials overleaf) in Aberdeen on June 2nd. The match will be financially assisted by the Association Match Fund.

The Prone quartet will be the 1983 Champion (W. Moonie) and the top three in a trials weekend to be held July/early August and involving the top 10 in the 1984 Order of Merit after Linwood Open and two invitees.

The PSK and Air Rifle representatives will be selected on 12th August (after Bisley PSK Championships). PSK candidates should keep the Secretary informed of progress and A/R candidates should enter the Summer 10 metre league.

300 metre (Big Bore) Prone has been added to the Games in Jersey. Any Member participating actively in this discipline should advise the Secretary without delay.
