Team Squad

The Final Trial for the 1986 Squad will be shot at Denwood in September, 1985. In place of a postal stage, performance to any of the following criteria will earn the right of non-squad shooters to take part in the Trial:-

- (a) Score 590 or more in any 1985 Grand Prix.
- (b) Finish in the top three of any Open Meeting.
- (c) Finish in the top twenty of 'X' and 'A' class (combined) aggregate at the Scottish or Bisley.
- (d) Finish in the top ten in the Haig Final.
- (e) Win a place in the Final of the Freuchie.
- (f) Win a place in the Final of the Earl Roberts at Bisley.

1985 Squad members not seeded into the 1986 Squad will also shoot the Final Trial.

Association Secretary
