The Final takes place at the Perth C. & C. range on Sunday, 21st March. Shooting will commence at 11.00 a.m. Competitors will shoot five separate 20 shot matches, each one against a different three other finalists. The drawn numbers beside names above correspond with the programme below.

Highest score in each match earns 6 points, second place - 4 points and third place - 2 points. Ties will result in sharing the appropriate points and the winner of the Bill Dick Memorial Trophy (annual challenge) will be the table leader on completion of the round of matches. Cash prizes of £15, £10, £7 and £5 will be paid for first, second, third and fourth. In the event of a tie for the trophy, tie shooting of 10-shot series will determine the winner but prize money will be shared.

The first eight in the final table gain automatic selection for the Scottish team to shoot against New Zealand, again at Perth. The seven other team members will be selected, taking into account composite performance in Speedway, Medal, Dragon Bowl and other relevant scores.

Any qualifier who becomes unable to attend is asked to contact me (phone work [redacted] or home [redacted] at the earliest opportunity and reserves will be invited in order. Reserves will be most welcome to attend (with gear just in case) as will all other supporters.
